



### **Day Itinerary 1: Arrival**

You will be met on arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport and transferred to Golf Safari House on the Kilimanjaro Golf & Wildlife Estate. On arrival at the Golf Safari House, you will be met by your golf captain and host during your stay at Kilimanjaro Golf & Wildlife Estate. She will brief you on the beautiful wildlife estate, the championship golf course and most importantly – the golf tournament! After a late dinner, it will be time to get some rest as the activities start tomorrow. ### **The Kilimanjaro Golf and Wildlife Estate**

Tucked between Mt Kilimanjaro and Mt Meru, the Kilimanjaro Golf and Wildlife Estate comprises an 18-hole championship golf course together with a real estate development set within an area of outstanding natural beauty. The estate is situated on over 400 hectares of African bush, approximately 25 kilometres from the tourism stopover of Arusha, and a similar distance from Kilimanjaro International Airport. The beauty of Tanzania's northern highlands provides the spectacular setting for this estate. Surrounded by the Maasai Steppe, and the great ridges of the ancient Eastern Arc chain: the Pare, Usambara and Blue Mountains, there are incredible views from every angle. This is the newest and most striking addition to Africa's great golfing estates and offers visitors the opportunity to enjoy a wildlife safari, horse riding adventures, cultural tours, and even helicopter tours.

### **Day 2: Golf activity**

At 08:00, after an early breakfast, the golfers among you will be transferred to the Kilimanjaro Golf & Wildlife Estate clubhouse, so that you can start preparing for your round of 18 holes. Tee off will start as of 09:00. Those of you who are non-golfers can enjoy exploring the beautiful wildlife estate and taking part in any one of the following activities: 1. 1-hour full body massage (in the garden at the Golf Safari House) 2. A half-day fun and educational coffee farm tour (by foot) 3. 1.5-hour excursion to go canoeing on Lake Duluti 4. 2-hour bird-watching walk on the golf course You will all reconvene at the Golf Safari House for lunch. Enjoy a relaxing lunch and an afternoon by the pool. • For those of you interested in taking part in another activity, why not saddle up for an unforgettable horse safari (\$100 per person) through the wildlife estate? This 2-hour activity, for any level of rider, will allow you to get right up close to zebra, wildebeest, eland, kudu and more. ### **Day 3: Flight to Serengeti**

After a relaxed breakfast, it will be time for your transfer service to the Dolly Airstrip, just a 10- minute drive away, where you will catch your flight to Serengeti. Arrive to camp in time for a delicious lunch. Depart 10:00 AM and arrive 12:05 PM (flight included in your tour). On arrival you will be met by your safari guide and transfer to Ole Serai Central camp for lunch followed by an afternoon game drive in the world renown Serengeti National Park. Dinner and overnight at Serengeti Serena Lodge / Ole Serai Central Camp on a full board basis.

### **Overnight: Ole Serai Luxury Camp Kogatende**

This Luxury Camp is strategically located within the northern (Kogatende) area of the famous Serengeti National Park in Tanzania and is set amidst the most prime areas of the Serengeti following the path of the great migration, sparsely inhabited by large Acacia as well as Tortilis Tree's and is home to several species of wildlife that reside in this area year- round due to catchments of water bodies around the area. ### **Ole Serai Luxury Camp Kogatende**

### **Northern Serengeti**

Located between the Central Serengeti and Kenya's Masai Mara National Reserve to the north, the Northern Serengeti is a remote African wildlife wonderland. The vast, rolling savannah of the Northern Serengeti, is known as the hub of the great migration. The landscape is characterised by vast stretches of savannah interspersed with acacia trees and riverine woodlands. Wildlife can be seen along the banks of the Mara River and visitors can view the annual spectacle of the half a million migrating wildebeest. Commonly spotted wildlife include: a multitude of plains game such as buffalo, zebra, gazelles, impala, giraffe as well as lion and leopard. Visitors can look forward to bird watching, hot air ballooning, game safaris and guided bush walks.

#### **Day 6: Depart for Ngorongoro conservation Area**

Depart after breakfast with picnic lunch and drive to Ngorongoro with stop at Olduvai Gorge Museum and continue to Ngorongoro Oldeani Mountain Lodge on a full board basis.

#### **Overnight: Ngorongoro Oldeani Mountain Lodge**

O'Ideni Ngorongoro Mountain Lodge is a colonial lodge situated on a picturesque hill with spectacular views of Oldeani Mountain and the Ngorongoro Crater Rim. The lodge is elevated, featuring spectacular views that extend all the way to Lake Eyasi and Lake Manyara. The property is set on 40 acres of lush green gardens and local vegetation, with over 130 species of birds. The lodge is accessed over a pond and one's first impression is the grand central hallway with wooden trusses looking out over the fireplace, infinity pool and out to Mount O'Ideni, which is part of the caldera of the Ngorongoro crater, only 12 km away. Basis Full Board Plus - Dinner, Bed, Breakfast, Lunch and activities.

#### **Day 7: Ngorongoro crater tour**

Full day Ngorongoro Crater tour with picnic lunch, and a visit to a Masai Village. Overnight Ngorongoro Oldeani Mountain Lodge.

#### **The Maasai**

A tribe that once subsisted mainly on the milk and blood of their cattle, but who once dined on bread and plum pudding with Ernest Hemingway. A pastoral people who inhabit the Serengeti area of Tanzania and Kenya, the Maasai present a colorful sight in their traditional dress and the ubiquitous spears in their hands. They are nomadic cattle, sheep and goat herders, who have had to adapt to modern times. Many have turned to agriculture and others have started living in the cities. But they are always happy to go back to their old ways whenever they return to their villages around the game parks. Some of these villages are open to tourists whom they entertain with their traditional dances, especially the famed udumu or jumping dance performed by Maasai men. The men are tall and athletic and call themselves warriors who during their initiation ceremonies in the past, had to prove their manhood by killing a lion with spears. Nowadays many Maasai warriors work as guides in the national game parks.

#### **Day 8: Drive back to Arusha**

After breakfast, you will be driven to Arusha and on arrival, transfer to Kilimanjaro Golf & Wildlife Estate. You will arrive at the Golf Safari House in time for lunch. After lunch, enjoy an afternoon of more

9-hole golf! Those of you who are non-golfers can enjoy exploring the beautiful wildlife estate, taking part in any one of the following activities: Stretching your legs after your journey in a safari vehicle.

To celebrate your final evening in Tanzania, you will go for sundowners at a special location on the golf course itself. With fantastic views of Mt. Meru and Mt. Kilimanjaro, this is the perfect spot to make a toast to the end of a wonderful trip. Return to the Golf Safari House for dinner. Overnight in Arusha at the Golf Safari House 4\*, 1 night in a double room.

### **Day 9: Tournament then transfer to the Airport**

Enjoy an easy breakfast this morning, then be transferred to the Kilimanjaro Golf & Wildlife Estate clubhouse for your final day of golf. Today is tournament day! Tee off will be between 8:30 and 9:00 AM. Your Tournament Captain will handle player registration and briefing prior to tee off. After 18 holes, there will be a lovely award ceremony in the clubhouse, after which all players will be transferred back to the Golf Safari House in time for a late lunch. Spend the rest of the afternoon packing, lounging by the pool and resting. You will be given a light dinner before you depart for the Kilimanjaro International Airport.
