The Golf Courses

Barnbougle Dunes Golf Course

Barnbougle Dunes is the closest thing to a seaside links as exists in Australia. The holes are routed through the dunes, some as high as 100 feet. It is an odd day when there isn't a zesty breeze to contend with, normally from the west which means you head into it immediately. The fairways are smart enough but not over cultured. They retain every warp and fold of the land on which they were placed and a few more besides. Many of the greens flow in a continuation of the surrounding land. This is a golf course made upstairs, as the saying has it.

Barnbougle Lost Farm Golf Course

Barnbougle Lost Farm is a breathtaking golf course, dramatically different yet complementary to both the surrounding landscape and the Barnbougle Dunes. Barnbougle Lost Farm is a 20 hole Links Golf course on Tasmania's North East Coast. And is sure to challenge golfers of all ages and abilities.

Despite the proximity of Lost Farm to Barnbougle Dunes, the two courses are remarkably different. The dunes on which Lost Farm is located are steeper and more dramatic than those of Barnbougle Dunes, which gives you two magnificent golf experiences.

King Island, Ocean Dunes Golf Course

Ocean Dunes complements the Cape Wickham Links course and completes the set of four outstanding new world class golf courses that have secured Tasmania's place as a top 21st Century world golfing destination

While many a golf course has been described as a true test of golf, Ocean Dunes might more accurately be described as, potentially, a true test of the golfer. Depending on prevailing winds it will test not only your golfing skills 'to the max' as it were, it will also test your stamina, your determination and your internal fortitude to an extent that few other golf courses do.

In under an hour from Melbourne, find yourself on King Island, where, at the north-eastern tip, surrounded by dramatic coastal scenery, you can play one of Australia's best kept secrets. There are stunning ocean vistas from every single hole on the course. The change in elevation on the fairways is dramatic, the bunkers are superb, and the scenery is stunning. Many golf courses have a standout hole but with Cape Wickham Golf Course, every hole is a standout.
